

SAFE HARBOR AGREEMENT

In order to preserve the safety and confidentiality of your child's therapeutic environment, it is essential that he/she feels free to speak openly with their therapist without fear of their statements being disclosed. The therapist's office is to serve as an environmental "safe harbor" for your child(ren). Please refrain from asking pointed questions about what is disclosed in the therapy process. Therefore, any information given by your child's therapist to other professionals will be maintained as confidential. Neither parent will permit his or her attorney to subpoena the information contained in the file or to subpoena the child's therapist for purposes related to separation, divorce or custody. I understand that this agreement is being made because it is in the best interest of the child(ren) to have confidential counseling services throughout the legal family proceedings.



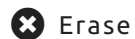


New Date Field
